1. The Department of Marine Services and Merchant Shipping wish to draw the attention of Companies, masters and officers to the **amended TSS of the existing Deep Water Rout North-East of Gedser.**

A deep-water route with a minimum depth of water below mean sea level of 17 meters is bounded by new and amended geographical positions which can be taken by the appropriate nautical publications.
