Circular letter to:

- 1. All companies having registered their ships under the flag of Antigua and Barbuda W.I.**
- 2. All ships registered under the flag of Antigua and Barbuda W.I.**
- 3. All relevant class societies.**

The Department of Marine Services and Merchant Shipping wish to draw the attention of class societies, companies, masters and officers to the new SOLAS 74, as amended, requirements which enter into force on the 01. July 2006.

1. SOLAS 74, as amended, Reg. V/28 requires, that a ship of 500 GT and above, engaged on international voyages exceeding 48 hrs shall submit a daily report to its company as defined in SOLAS IX-1.
2. The report shall contain the following:
 - .1 ship's position
 - .2 ship's course and speed, and
 - .3 details of any external or internal conditions that are affecting the ship's voyage or the normal safe operation of the ship.
3. SOLAS V/2, V/22 and V/28 have been amended accordingly.
